<u>Cheerleading Coach</u>	<u>£1225.00</u>	Cheerleading has continued to be a great success at William Austin. The coach delivered an after school session with the support of Mrs Harnett. The children were working towards the Luton Town cheerleading competition. They competed in this and came 2 nd . They then took part in the County Finals and came 4 th . This club has continued to boost the confidence of the children in our school whilst allowing them to try something different.
	<u>£255.00</u>	For our competitions we also ordered new pomp oms in our school colours from a cheerleading specialist. These give the children a great sense of unity when performing as they are representing both our school and themselves.
<u>Active Luton</u>	<u>£168.00</u>	Active Luton have supported staff in the delivery of their games lessons and given guidance for organisation of the class and equipment when using different outdoor spaces. This has helped develop the confidence and knowledge of the games staff whilst also allowing them to transfer their knowledge to different activities. The focus has been on the level of activity the children receive through games.
<u>Sports Medals</u>	<u>£126.42</u>	Medals were ordered for children who had shown excellent progress in PE throughout the year. This was to demonstrate positive behaviour and progress amongst all pupils. We also ordered a Gold place sports day medal for the overall winning house.

<u>Equipment</u>	<u>£1685.31</u>	We are continuing the good use of the groupings in PE lessons and have purchased more bibs, whistles and matching cones to further develop this. We also purchased new sized dodgeballs to better equip our children for dodgeball tournaments. We ordered new cricket and rounders equipment to ensure a greater number of children were able to access clubs and take part fully in lesson. This has meant great success for both cricket and rounders teams. Our rounders team was entered into the National Finals, and as a

		school we travelled to Leicester where the pupils played extremely well and came 5 th . Our cricket team got the county finals.
<u>Field Markings</u>	<u>£506.68</u>	4 rounders pitches so smaller groups were utilised in lesson time, more children able to access the club and as a school we were able to host the Luton Town and County Finals on our field. We competed in both the Town and County competitions and entered two teams into both. We came 1 st at County.
<u>Dance Coach</u>	<u>£250.00</u>	The dance coach offered a lunchtime club to all children. It was available to all year groups and over 100 children attended. The pupils enjoy trying something new and it allows their creativity to develop. Whilst building on the confidence and self-esteem of our children it helps create positive working relationships for all children.
<u>Football Coach</u>	<u>£350.00</u>	The football coach delivered training sessions to further develop football at William Austin. This was accessible to all year groups in the autumn term. It allowed children to access qualities such as teamwork and communication. Pupils were able to work on their independence as they were given opportunity to referee small sided games, another important part of any sport.
<u>Table Tennis Competition</u>	<u>£20.00</u>	We entered the County Table Tennis Tournament with 6 year 6 children during February half term. It was important for the children to further their table tennis knowledge and play in a county tournament. They enjoyed the opportunity and it was a great challenge for them all. All their hard work at training paid off as 5 of our children were ranked in the top 8 of the county.
<u>Stickers</u>	<u>£161.13</u>	Stickers were used to identify sports stars of the week in PE lessons. This was open to all children in all year groups. We also purchased super star and star stickers to reward children for exceptional contributions in PE as well as in clubs and fixtures.
<u>British Gymnastics</u>	<u>£75.83</u>	Our year subscription to the British Gymnastics enables us to receive resources for lessons and clubs, be a part of an organisation where we can utilise their resources, schemes, courses and workshops.
<u>Netball Coach</u>	<u>£100.00</u>	We have used a netball coach to encourage participation in this sport as we entered a netball league. This was accessible to Year 5 & 6 in the autumn term. We had maximum numbers at each session and the pupils really enjoyed it. A team was created who competed against other schools in a Netball League.

<u>Ad-hoc Expenses</u>	<u>£46.85</u>	To further develop our groupings in PE lessons we purchased some boxes for bibs, whistles and white boards to be stored for each team in each class and also pocket wallets to allow each teams scores to be stored correctly and in a tidy manner.
<u>Further Transport</u>	<u>£350.00</u>	Where we have qualified for county games and required a bigger vehicle than the one we have we have instructed the use of a coach. For example, cheerleading we required a coach to take the team. The children came 4 th in Bedfordshire.
