

# Let's get back to school!

Schools will reopen to all pupils from **8 March**.

Returning to school is very important for your child's education, happiness and friendships.

Your child's school has put strong measures in place to help reduce risk of infection and create a safe place for your child, for example:



different classes coming back at different times



different pick up and drop off times



frequent cleaning of surfaces and equipment



frequent hand washing



'catch it, kill it, bin it' – encouraging good respiratory hygiene



your child will stay with their class or year group 'bubble' and won't mix much with others

If you are worried about your child returning please contact the school directly so they can reassure you of the measures they have in place.

Schools will be contacting parents and carers directly to inform them of their return to school arrangements.

To reduce the spread of the virus and to protect your school community, all households with children are advised to **get a rapid test** before children return to school.
