Word of the week - consistency

For example:

- Ways to be consistent, to help you achieve your goals:
1. Small steps - set small goals that you can achieve.
 2. Create a plan of how to work towards your goals.
 3. Use your time wisely - do things that help you stay mentally and physically healthy, while never giving up and working on the small steps you set for yourself to complete.
 4. Accept that you are human and that you can take a break or fall off schedule, so long as you get back on track when you are ready.

Word of the week - diversity

Diversity means differences. People may be different in many ways, including race or ethnicity, age, disabilities, language, culture, appearance, or religion. When someone thinks negatively about another person simply because they are different, this is called a prejudice.

- We can celebrate diversity by:
- recognising that we are all unique and special in different ways
 - celebrating our similarities and differences
 - ask questions about different cultures, religions, abilities, disabilities, ages, ethnicities, races, appearances etc. to learn and understand other people
 - respect the differences between people
 - practice unity by not separating from people if they are different to you, based on those differences
 - use kind language towards all
 - behave in a kind manner towards everyone that is similar or different to you
 - correcting someone if they are speaking or behaving unkindly towards another, because of their differences

Geography

This term the children at William Austin Junior school will be studying the following topics: Year 3 will be learning about Italy, where the country is, comparing its physical and human features with a place in UK. In year 4, the children will be learning where chocolate comes from. In year 5, the children will be studying all about Alaska, where it is, its features and investigating natural disasters that this country has experienced. Finally, in year 6 children will be learning all about the landscape and how different settlements develop.
