School Dinner payments

The cost of dinner money in the Junior School is £12.50 a week. Payment is made through scopay.com. Parents will be given a link code from the school kitchen with information on how to create an account. This will enable you to pay on line. An app is also available from the App Store.

Payment should be made in advance for the following week’s dinners. It is parents’ responsibility to ensure their child’s account is always in credit. Setting up a direct debit with your bank is a good way to ensure payment is made on time.
